Small Business:

A business with no more than 40 full-time employees or full-time equivalent.

To emphasize the importance of small business to the economy and welfare of the entire Hanover community, the Hanover Area Chamber of Commerce will again recognize among its members the Small Business of the Year that best exemplifies sound principles of business success, personnel management, and community leadership and service.

Eligibility:

- Any Chamber member with no more than 40 full-time employees or full-time equivalent.
- Business entities, including proprietors, partnerships or corporations doing business in or located in the Hanover Chamber area.
- A business may apply directly or be nominated by another member.
- Chamber officers' businesses are not eligible.

Criteria:

- Business must have operated at least three years in the area.
- Must show evidence of success and sound growth.
- Must be a visible presence in the community.
- Must be active in support of community organizations and events
